Criteria for Application for Funding/Organization Requirements:

- Your organization must directly benefit the children of the greater Holland/surrounding area
- Exist as a non-profit organization and send a copy of a 501©(3) letter or a government affirmation letter
- Agree to send HJWL copies of receipts upon distribution of funds for your specific request(s) by the stated deadline of August 31 of the year funding was provided
- Agree to return any funds not used as stated in your application
- Agree not to request funds to cover salaries as we are unable to supply that need
